

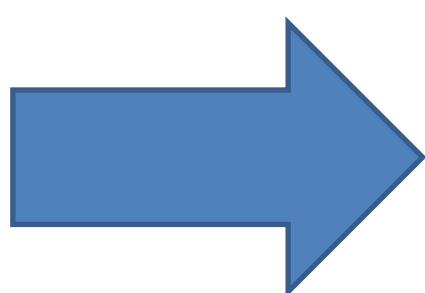
granton:hub's vision is to repurpose the beautiful and historic Madelvic House as a thriving creative and cultural centre, providing benefits to both the local and wider community.
